Richard Costa is Director of the PEO C3T Special Projects Office. He initiated his career in the United States Government in October of 1981.

Mr. Costa has served in a variety of leadership and staff positions during his career. His initial assignment was as a Secondary and Major Item Manager for Night Vision and Electronics equipment within the Communications and Electronics Command, Directorate of Materiel Management (CECOM DMM). He then served as an Integrated Logistics (ILS) Manager for PM Army Tactical Communications Systems (PM ATACS). Mr. Costa then undertook several assignments associated with the Mobile Subscriber Equipment (MSE) Program, including: ILS Manager, Training Manager, ILS Division Chief and Deputy Fielding Team Chief, US Army Europe (USAREUER).

He was later assigned to an International Program Management Office within the PMs for Warfighter Information Network-Tactical (WIN-T) and Tactical Radio Communications Systems (TRCS), where he has led Security Assistance activities and Command, Control, Communications and Computer (C4) acquisitions for international programs. During this tenure, his roles included Readiness Management Division Chief and Product Director, which assumed management responsibility for several US Army Area Common User System (ACUS) programs. In February 2009, Mr. Costa was reassigned as the Deputy Director of the PEO C3T Special Projects Office and he has since assumed the duties of Director.

Mr. Costa is a member of the Army Acquisition Corps. He has attended the Naval Post Graduate School for Acquisition Program Management and the Defense Acquisition University for Acquisition Logistics. He has attained Level III certification in both Acquisition Career Fields.
